Presently planned presentations and programs

It is our ultimate goal to establish both a science education institution and a research laboratory that focus on the sciences and technologies that will effect sudden and dramatic changes to the future of our civilization, improving the lives and fortunes of our fellow humans and bringing peace to our planet.

Both the Arts and Sciences are necessary to make our world kinder, gentler and more livable. Until we can initiate the first steps toward our ultimate goal we will offer a number of presentations in both the Arts and Sciences that will be available on the Internet and are intended to educate the people of the world in the sciences so that they may realize that science is the only way they will ever achieve a rewarding life for themselves and their descendants.

The Arts presentations on our website will feature works and excerpts from works of authors, composers, choreographers, and visual artists that critically examine our society and/or make social commentary and protests or show us what it will be like if our world were fixed.

The Science presentations will be videos of 5 to 15 minutes duration contributed by guest scientists. These presentations will be available on our website and be pitched to the layperson with at least a high school education and will be about subjects in the sciences principally for the diffusion of general knowledge to the public: cosmology; basic physics; meteorology, biology and bio-genetics; health and medicine; human behavioral and political sciences. They will stress the concepts of "cause and effect" and "scientific method" and will also explain how these sciences as well as the specific research being done by the presenter can help "fix" the world. The website presentations will also be used to solicit support for research being performed or proposed by scientists as chosen by the Institute as supporting and furthering our goals.

Research being sponsored or done by the Institute will be the object of presentations including research on educational and logistical methods for bringing the arts and sciences to every corner and stratum of the world. Of principal interest will be our support of, and research in, Low Energy Nuclear Reactions or LENRs which we think are the energy source of the future and possibly a principal tool for saving our Civilization.

As funds become available, the Institute will also produce Science Conferences, Art Exhibitions, Concerts and Theatrical Productions to disseminate our ideas. Proceeds from these activities will be used to further support the purposes of the organization.

In addition to these Internet presentations, conferences and productions, the Institute also plans to eventually broadcast using "Free to Air" satellites in the Ka band as soon as there are extra channels available and we have the funds. These broadcasts will require development of inexpensive receiving equipment that can be distributed free to areas of the world that do not have or permit this kind of knowledge.
